Bill Mauldin

Bill Mauldin, Pulitzer Prize wining WWII cartoonist who captured the life of the GI infantryman, died last month at Newport Beach, CA. He was 81.

His two characters Joe and Willie mirrored the soldiers who slogged their way through mud, cold, and bloody battles in Italy.

He died at a nursing home of complications from Alzheimer's disease, including pneumonia, said Andy Mauldin, one of his seven sons.

PROFILE

S/Sgt Peter O'Neill was a gunner on the J. Fred Thomas crew in the 579th. They flew their first mission on May 24, 1944 and their 30th on August 1, probably a record for completing a tour in the 392nd.

In August 1945 he was a member of a special unit that took 20 new experimental A-26's to New Guinea, the Phillippines, and finally Okinawa.

O'Neill reports, "Exciting stuff! In the 392nd we flew as high as power permitted, and the A-26's flew 30-50 feet above the water, as low as prudence permitted. It was a fearless/stupid 19 year old kid's dream!

'Civilian life has been almost as exciting. Living in Europe, then 35 years in Asia, running my own businesses. Life has been an uninterrupted good time.

'Fred Thomas has done a remarkable job of keeping the crew glued together. A medal is merited."

O'Neill lives in Macau.

SO. CAL. 2ADA REGIONAL MEET AT LOS ALAMITOS


The 392nd was well represented among the some 200 attendees at the Los Alamitos Race Track on Feb. 22.


